Davos, Switzerland – 13 January 2026 – As global leaders gather for the World Economic Forum (WEF) Annual Meeting next week, InTent at Davos will once again provide a trusted space for conversations on environmental, social and governance issues. Our sessions are open to non-white card holders on inscription on the official website ([programme](#)). Our 2026 programme links nature, leadership and systems change, because climate, biodiversity, technology and social cohesion are now inseparable challenges. The ambition is practical: to build partnerships, scalable tools and credible accountability standards that help to redirect capital, policy and innovation toward resilient outcomes. If we want enduring prosperity, we must learn to create long-term value within planetary boundaries, and do so together.”

Throughout the week of WEF, Hotel National becomes home to InTent at Davos, an inclusive and open space recognised within the WEF ecosystem as a trusted destination for impact-driven dialogue around environmental, social and governance issues.
